The Department of History strongly encourages its majors to start their foreign language study in their first year. Foreign languages currently offered at IPFW are Arabic, French, German, Japanese, Latin and Spanish. Students who have completed two years of a foreign language in high school and who want to continue in that language to satisfy the foreign language requirement should take a placement exam and/or consult with their department advisor.

IPFW General Education Requirements:

Foundational Intellectual Skills: Written Communication (A1): ENG W131 (3 credits)

Foundational Intellectual Skills: Listening & Speaking (A2): HIST H125 (3 credits)

Foundational Intellectual Skills: Quantitative Reasoning (A3): MA 14000 or
STAT 12500 or MA 15300 (3 credits)

Scientific Ways of Knowing (B4): Course needs to include a lab (3-4 credits)

Social & Behavioral Ways of Knowing (B5): (3 credits)

Humanistic & Artistic Ways of Knowing (B6): This competency is satisfied by any of the introductory survey courses in the History major (3 credits)

Interdisciplinary Ways of Knowing (B7): (3 credits)

Additional General Education Electives (A1, A2, A3, B4, B5, B6, B7): (9 credits)

Capstone (C8): Must be taken at IPFW (3 credits) (*There are a number of upper-level history courses approved for this category.*)

Departmental Requirements:

1. The history survey courses can be taken in any sequence. You do not need to take H105 before H106, or H113 before H114. You can take the Western Civilization survey courses before or at the same time that American survey courses are taken.
2. HIST H217 fulfills the second-semester writing requirement for History majors. It is offered only in the fall semester. HIST H217 is designed to prepare students for their upper-level, research-oriented history courses and should be taken in the sophomore year. Delay in taking H217 could result in delays in graduation and difficulties in upper-level history courses. ENG W233 **cannot** be used to fulfill the second-semester writing requirement for History majors.
3. HIST H125 "Great Debates" is a required course for History majors, designed to fulfill the A2 Speaking & Listening General Education requirements. It is only offered in the spring semester, and should be taken in the freshman year.
4. HIST H217 and HIST J495 **cannot** be taken in the same semester.
5. HIST J495 is never offered in the summer.

Students need a grade of C- or above in all History courses used in the major and a GPA of 2.00 or higher for all major department courses taken.
