Emerging Artist Recital: Jason Simon, solo and collaborative piano

Jason Simon (B.M. Piano Performance '14) is currently pursuing a doctorate in piano performance at the Cleveland Institute of Music, where he studies with internationally renowned pianist Antonio Pompa-Baldi. The first part of his program will include Mozart's Sonata in B-flat Major, K. 333 and Ravel's *Sonatine*; he will then collaborate with violinist Carina Vincenti in Beethoven's Sonata in A Major, Op. 47 "Kreutzer."
