We offer a Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) degree, a Bachelor of Fine Arts (B.F.A.) degree, a Bachelor of Arts in Art Education (B.A. Art Education) degree, a B.S. Interior Design degree as well as a Minor in Art History and Art and Design. Please read and follow the directions.

Students must submit artwork digitally:

- Please send the images in a PowerPoint presentation via a Dropbox link. Each slide should include artwork and the following information for each piece: the title, media, and size.
- Create a title page for your PowerPoint presentation with your name, high school, email address, phone number and prospected major area of study.
- Please include twelve (12) of your strongest works.
- Submission images must not exceed the resolution of 72 dpi and a size of 768 x 1024 pixels. All artwork submitted must be original work done by the applicant.
- Email your PowerPoint with the completed application form to finearts@ipfw.edu.
- The applications will be accepted from November 3, 2017, through February 2, 2018.
