

1. On the device, tap the **All Settings** icon.
2. Tap **Wi-Fi**.
3. Make sure Wi-Fi is turned **ON**.
4. Under **Available Wi-Fi Networks...**
  - a. For Faculty or Staff: Tap **IPFW Faculty Staff**.
  - b. For Students: Tap **IPFW Student**



5. Under **Connect Using User Name + Password** enter your IPFW credentials:
  - a. **Username:** your IPFW username.
  - b. **Password:** your IPFW password.
    - i. **Note:** When you change your IPFW password, you will need to update it here.
6. Under **Server Certificate** choose **always ask me**
7. Under **EAP Method** choose **PEAP MS-CHAP v2**
8. Tap **Done**
