**Whereas**, Senate Document SD 92-7 provides that "each unit (school, department, program, center, etc.) that serves as the academic home for students-undergraduate and graduate-shall formulate a statement of mission, goals, and objectives consistent with IPFW's statement of mission, goals, and objectives";  
and

**Whereas**, Mission statements of the School of Business and Management Sciences were approved in Senate Documents SD 93-27 and SD 94-13; and

**Whereas**, The School of Business and Management Sciences has proposed further revisions to its mission statement as shown below;

**Resolved**, That the Senate approve the following revised mission statement of the School of Business and Management Sciences.

The mission of the School of Business and Management Sciences is to create and deliver educational programs in business, organizational leadership and supervision, and consumer and family sciences designed to prepare students primarily from northeast Indiana for professional careers. The School's programs are designed to prepare students for roles of increasing responsibility and prominence in their careers as well as for responsible citizenship to their profession and to their community in a global society.

The focus of the School shall be the development and delivery of effective instruction and the development of an environment conducive to learning. Intellectual contributions and creative endeavors in the School shall emphasize applied scholarship and instructional development studies appearing in media of quality. Basic scholarship shall also be rewarded. Service shall be the application of scholarly expertise to serve the School's various constituencies.
