Curriculum committee

Educational Policy committee

The following addition to the school requirement regarding credit for military service was presented by I. Hack. The EPC committee recommended the addition on November 25, 2002. This will be an addition to the requirements outlined on page 24 in the IPFW Bulletin.

Credit for military service. Each department in the School of Engineering, Technology, and Computer Science will determine whether credit for participation in military service may be applied toward a degree.
