Accessing and Logging in

Accessing BryteWave

To get to **BryteWave**,

- Go to **reader.brytewave.com**

Or

- Go to **Blackboard** > Select **your course** > click the link for your book.

Logging in

Accessing your course's book through **Blackboard** will automatically bring you to the **BryteWave** login page.

You should already be able to log in with your **IPFW credentials** but if you can't,

- Create an account with your **IPFW credentials**.

If it says your email is already set up with an account,

- Click **Forgot Password** and enter in your **IPFW email**. Once you get the email and change your password, go

back to **BryteWave** and try logging in again.

Books

Downloading Books

To download a title,

1. Log in to **BryteWave** and access the **Library**.
2. Click **Manage Titles** > find the **Title** you want to download.
3. Click **Download Now**.

Or

1. While inside the **Title Reading View**, select the **Menu Icon**.
2. Select **Download This Title**.

Downloading an App

To download an app,

1. Log in to **BryteWave**.
2. Click the **Menu Icon** in the **Library View**.
3. Select **Download Apps**.

Activating a Book

To activate a book,

1. While logged in to **BryteWave**, under **Add a Title**, enter in the book's **PIN Code**.
2. Hit **Enter**.

Reading View Options

Menu

In the **BryteWave Menu**, you can access the help site, settings, BryteWave Apps, and the ability to log out.

Navigation

- Click the **Left** and **Right** arrows to flip between pages.
- Scroll navigation jumps between pages.
- The **Go To** feature lets you jump to a specific page.

Adjusting Page View

1. Click a **book** in the **Library Displays Reading View** of a **BryteWave Title**.
2. On any page you can adjust the view by clicking the zoom in and out buttons.

Note: Distraction free mode can be accessed by double-clicking the page.

Highlighting

To highlight text,

1. Select text by dragging your cursor across the section you want to highlight.
2. Select the **Highlight** from the bottom toolbar.

You can also change the highlighter color if you want.

To remove a highlight, select the text and click **No Color**.

From the menu, you can click **Notes and Highlights** to view a summary of all the notes and highlights that have been saved in the **BryteWave Title**. You can view all of your highlights that have been saved throughout the **Title** by clicking **Saved Highlights**.

Notes

In the **Reading View**,

1. Click the **Note** option on the tool bar and the note creation field displays.
2. Here you can enter a title and body for your note.
 - a. If you click **Share with Others at your School**, the note becomes viewable with others at your school that have this digital book.

You can also view other's shared notes by clicking **Notes from Others**.

Copying and Printing

The **Copy and Print** options can be found in the bottom toolbar. These have a designated percent of the Title that you can copy. The number of copies and page prints is determined by the publisher's settings.

You can select a section of text you want to copy and click **Copy > Continue > CTRL + C**.

To **Print**, click the **Print** button, enter the page range, then click **Continue**.

Bookmark

To bookmark a page, simply click the **bookmark icon** and the page is added to your bookmark list.

In the **Menu**, click **Bookmarks** to get the **Bookmarks view**. Here, you can title or delete them, and jump to a bookmarked page.

Search

In the **Menu**, you can use the **Search bar** to search not only your book, but notes as well.

Display Options

Display Options gives you the ability to adjust your digital textbook to create a comfortable reading environment. Options include a one or two page view, fit-to-width or fit-to-height, the ability to zoom in or out, and background color adjustment.
