The committee met on Monday, March 31 to review the applications for the ETCS Excellence Awards. The work of the Committee is governed by Assembly Document 90-1, amended March 1, 2010.

The results of the meeting are as follows:

1. Two applications were disqualified for not following the instructions set out in Assembly Document 90-1 (i.e., incomplete applications or including too much supporting material).
2. Among the remaining applicants, the committee did not find sufficient evidence of excellence in teaching or in research to select a recipient in those categories. However, the committee recognizes the applicants' potential for excellence in these categories and would like to encourage them to reapply after strengthening their application materials.
3. The committee selected **Dr. Elizabeth Thompson** to receive the **Excellence Award in Service**. Dr. Thompson has done an exemplary job in organizing the Opportunity Banquet and advising The Society of Women Engineers. She was recognized for this work at a national level, receiving the Outstanding Faculty Advisor award from The Society of Women Engineers.
