The Chair noted that the committee may not make an award in every category, if, in the opinion of the committee, the nominees are not strong enough.

The results of the meeting are as follows:

1. Teaching

For the 2013 Excellence in Teaching Award, the committee selected Dr. Dong Chen. The committee felt that Dr. Chen deserves the award for effective teaching in and outside the classroom.

2. Research

For the 2013 Excellence in Research Award, the committee selected Dr. Zhuming Bi. The committee generally felt that Dr. Bi's research is quite original, of interdisciplinary significance and reported in a number of publications. The committee felt that Dr. Bi deserves the award for 2013.

3. Service

For the 2013 Excellence in Service Award, the committee selected Omonowo David Momoh. David's service work has impacted a lot of students, faculty, and the community. He has been involved with the African students association, the IEEE, the local engineering organization, accreditation, and a number of committees on campus at the department and higher levels. Because of the breadth of his activities the committee decided to give the 2013 Service Award to David Momoh.
