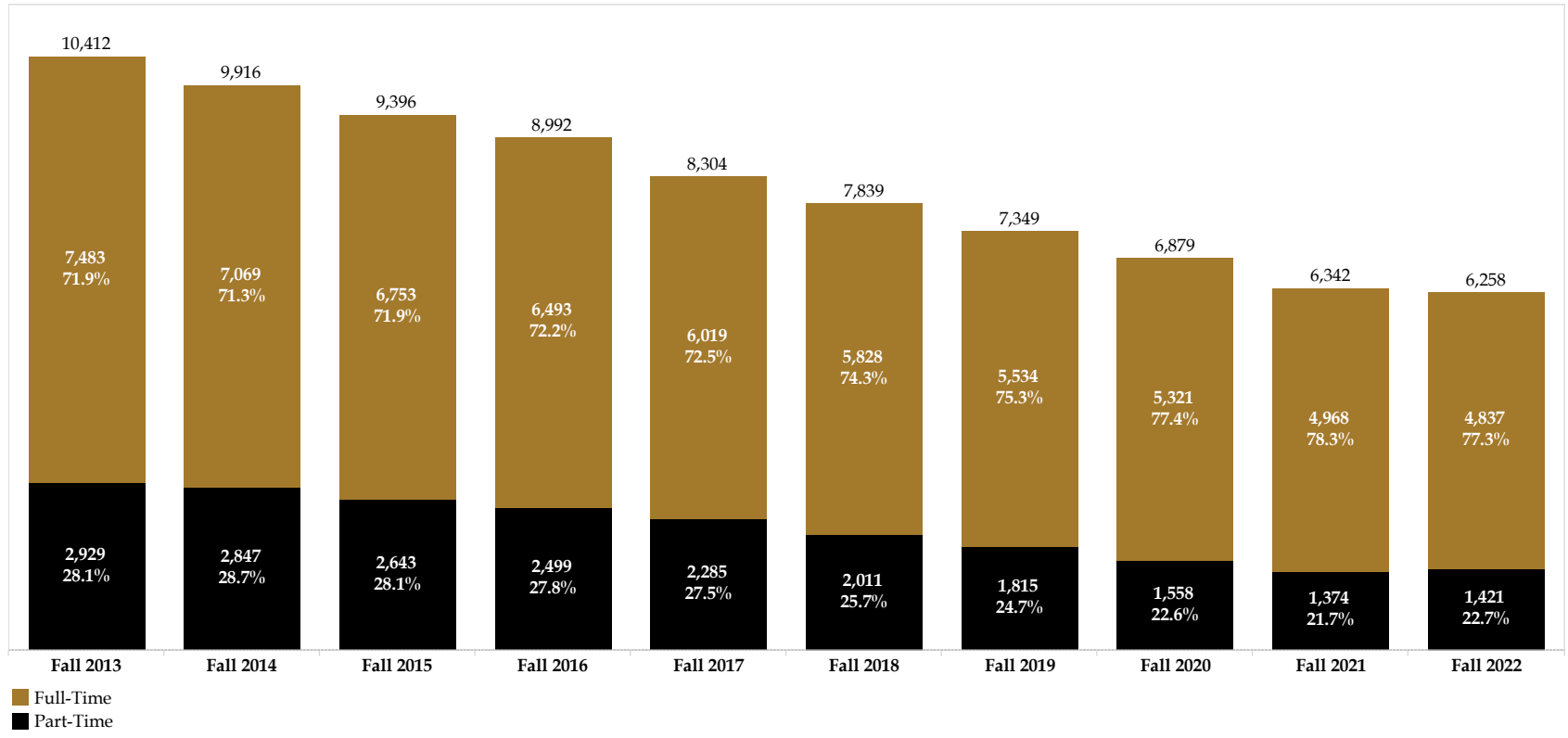

Notes:

- a. Student enrollment is counted if a student is registered for at least one course on the census snapshot date for each fall semester. Student enrollment includes degree-seeking and non-degree seeking undergraduate and graduate students.
- b. Academic categorization of undergraduate and graduate students is based on a student's primary academic program of study. The Graduate Level encompasses Masters, Doctor of Nursing Practice, and Graduate Certificates. The Undergraduate Level encompasses Associates, Baccalaureates, and Undergraduate Certificates. Non-degree seeking students are identified at both the Undergraduate and Graduate levels.
- c. Federal Full-Time / Part-Time per IPEDS data definitions (Notes: IPEDS does not define full-time for the summer semester)
 - i. Full-Time - Undergraduate: A student enrolled for 12 or more semester credit hours.
 - ii. Full-Time - Graduate / Professional: A student enrolled for 9 or more semester credit hours.
 - iii. Part-Time - Undergraduate: A student enrolled for less than 12 semester credit hours.
 - iv. Part-Time - Graduate: A student enrolled for less than 9 semester credit hours.
