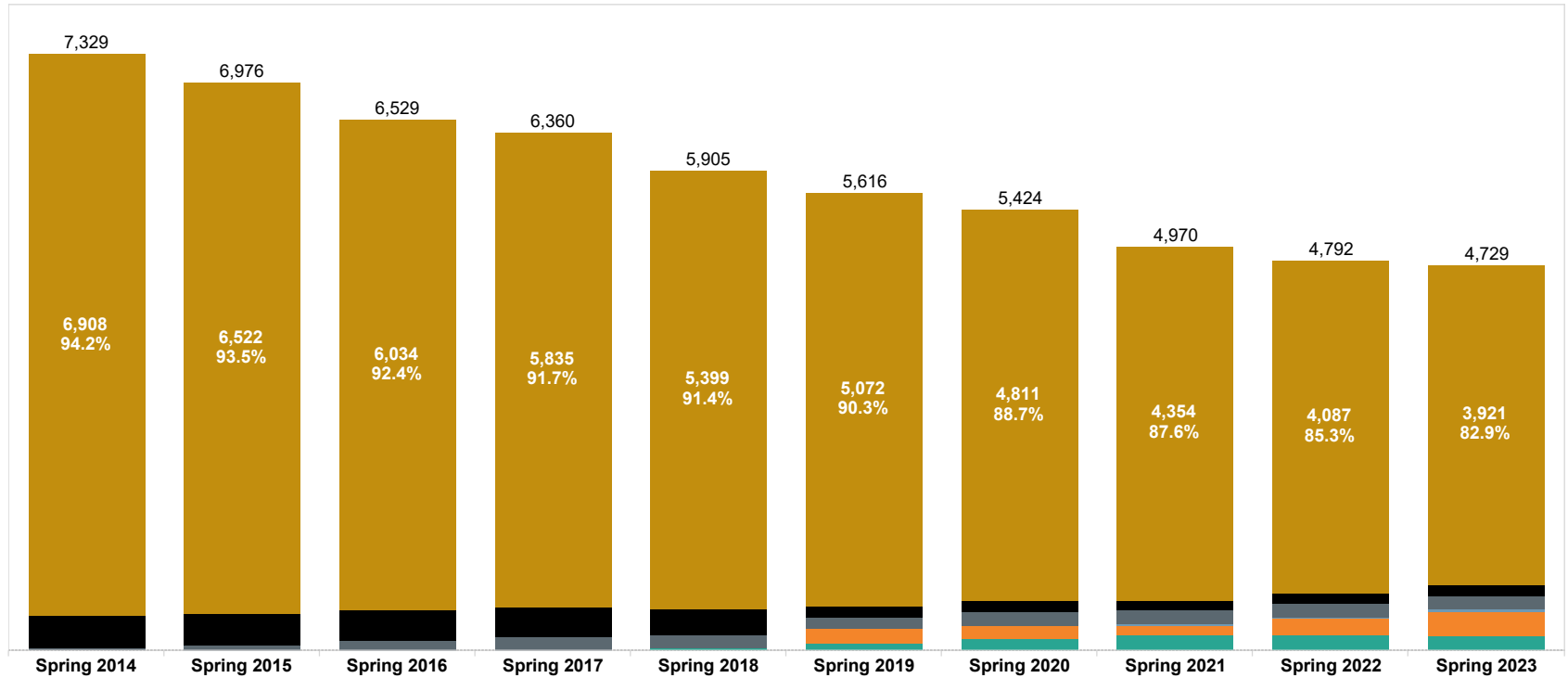

Notes:

- a. Student enrollment is counted if a student is registered for at least one course on the census snapshot date for each fall semester. Student enrollment includes degree-seeking and non-degree seeking undergraduate and graduate students.
- b. The assessment of tuition and fee rates are based on where a student or student's family live. There are four broad residency categories: Resident (also called in-state), Non-resident, Tuition Reciprocity States, and International. Tuition Reciprocity programs include Midwest Student Exchange Program, Ohio Reciprocity agreement counties, and residents in the four states contiguous to Indiana (Illinois, Michigan, Ohio, and Kentucky).
