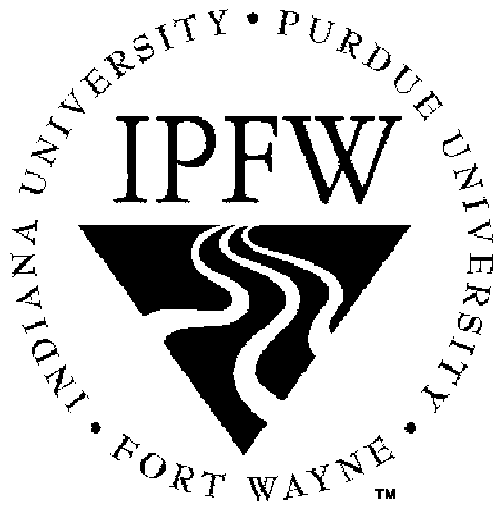

Civil and Architectural Engineering Technology and Mechanical and Industrial Engineering Technology departments combined to form Manufacturing and Construction Engineering Technology and Interior Design in 2008 - prior years restated. Academic Counseling and Career Services changed to Mastodon Advising Center in 2008. Most pre-business students moved from Mastodon Advising Center to Business and Management Sciences in 2008. Some courses moved between departments in Education in 2008. Electrical and Computer Engineering Technology changed to Computer and Electrical Engineering Technology and Informations Systems and Technology in 2008.
