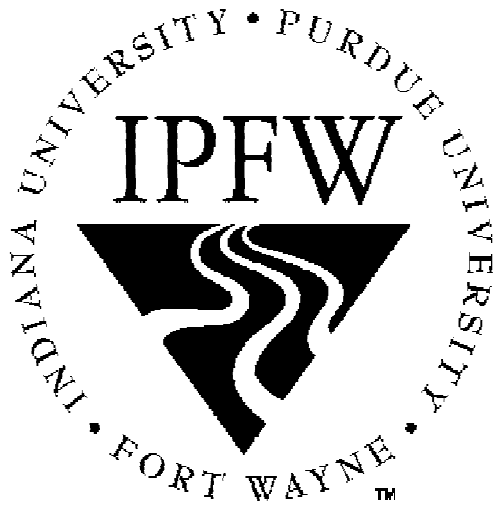

Audiology and Speech Sciences changed to Communication Sciences and Disorders in 2009. The department of Business and Management Sciences changed to Business Administration in 2011. The School of Education and the Division of Public and Environmental Affairs combined to form the College of Education and Public Policy in 2011, and the department of Public and Environmental Affairs changed to Public Policy in 2011--prior years restated. Information Systems programs moved from CEIT to Computer Science in 2011.
