

Graduate Assistantships

The following are the expectations for Graduate Assistantships:

- 1. Graduate Assistantship appointments will be 50.0 CUL (20 hours/week) unless departments collaborate to hire a graduate assistant who works 25.0 CUL (10 hours/week) for each department. Requests for exceptions to this policy should be directed to the Director of Graduate Studies.
- 2. In 2017, the number of Graduate Assistantships will begin to be distributed in a manner similar to the LTL pool. Currently, departments are budgeted for X number of Graduate Assistants. At the end of each year, the appointments will be reviewed and adjustments will be made depending on the need.
- 3. Departments that add Graduate Assistantships beyond the previously approved number will pay the stipends and tuition remission for each additional appointment.
- Externally funded Graduate Assistantships may be added at any time and will be limited to the grant period. The tuition remission should be included in the grant budget.
