This conference theme offers an opportunity for faculty members and student development personnel to submit a relatively wide range of proposals. Proposal topics could include:

Lessons learned from:

- Strategies to increase student engagement across modalities
- Culturally relevant teaching; i.e. first-generation, adult, millennials and international students
- Using technology to enhance learning
- Strategies to assess student performance

This is not an exhaustive list. We encourage proposals for 20 and 45-minute sessions or round table discussions from a wide range of approaches.

Submission Deadline: Proposals must be submitted electronically no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, November 16th, 2018.
