Purdue Fort Wayne Well-being and Recreation (WellRec) has partnered with LabCorp to provide confidential health screenings throughout the year. The **Wellness Panel**, an excellent tool for determining general health, is being offered for **FREE\*\*** to all campus employees/spouses and retirees/spouses (one per calendar year), as well as other single non-fasting tests.

You may pay with cash or a check (make check payable to Purdue Fort Wayne). Payment is due the time of service. Employees may submit receipts to their HSA for reimbursement.

## NON-FASTING TESTS OFFERED AT ADDITIONAL LOW COST

<b>Blood Type</b> Useful when a blood transfusion becomes necessary or if you wish to donate blood.	<b>Cost: \$12.00</b>
<b>Complete Blood Count (CBC)</b> Used to evaluate overall health and detect a wide range of disorders, including anemia, infection and leukemia.	<b>Cost: \$10.00</b>
<b>COVID-19 Antibody Test</b> Can detect if a person has antibodies to the virus that causes COVID-19. It can identify who may have been infected with COVID-19 or have recovered from the infection.	<b>Cost: \$45.00</b>
<b>C-Reactive Protein</b> Measures inflammation (C-RP) produced in liver and muscle cells within the coronary arteries. Elevated C-RP may increase the risk of heart attack, stroke, rheumatoid arthritis, cancer and lupus.	<b>Cost: \$20.00</b>
<b>Hemoglobin A1C</b> Measures average blood sugar levels for the past 3 months.	<b>Cost: \$20.00</b>
<b>Prostate Specific Antigen (PSA)</b> Useful in alerting men to the possible presence of prostate cancer and other prostate abnormalities in combination with a doctor's digital rectal examination.	<b>Cost: \$20.00</b>
<b>Thyroid Stimulating Hormone (TSH)</b> Detects several thyroid gland disorders which may cause weight gain, depression, forgetfulness, fatigue, vision problems, enlarged thyroid glands, and other health problems.	<b>Cost: \$20.00</b>
<b>Vitamin D</b> Measures the 25 vitamin D levels. Deficiency can be associated with increased risk of cardiovascular disease, diabetes and hypertension.	<b>Cost: \$35.00</b>
<b>Wellness Panel</b> Includes <b>full lipid profile</b> (total cholesterol, triglyceride, HDL, LDL, cholesterol/HDL ratio) and a <b>full blood chemistry panel</b> (includes glucose, kidney/ liver function and more). <b>You must fast 10-12 hours.</b> Sips of water with regular medications are okay. <b>**FREE</b> once per calendar year for all employees/spouses, and retirees/spouses.	<b>**FREE</b> <b>Cost: \$15.00</b>
