

According to Krissy Surface, vice chancellor for enrollment management and the student experience, potential PFW students

traveled from Indiana, Michigan, Ohio, Illinois, Florida, and Kentucky. Participants ranged from high school sophomores to students from other universities considering a transfer. And for the first time, those transfer students were offered their own information session to drill down on that process.

The numbers for the 2023–24 academic year look promising, Surface reported. Of those who attended Spring Campus Visit Day, 54% have already been admitted to PFW. That's helping boost overall incoming enrollment numbers that show applications are up 27% year to date, admissions 17%, and intent to enroll 85%. **READ ARTICLE**


