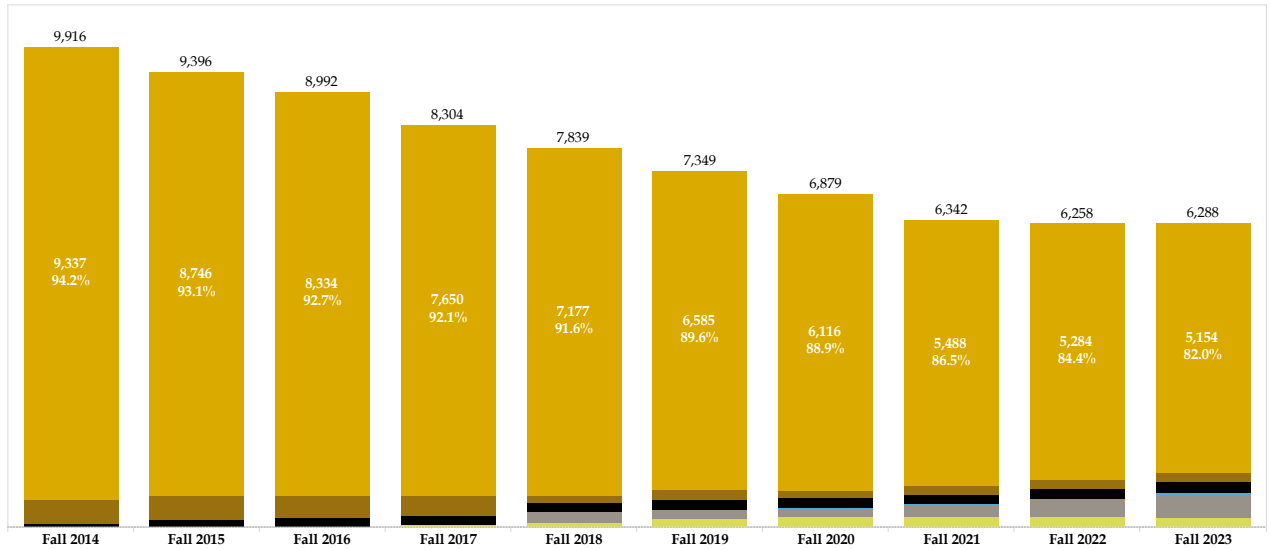

Notes:

- a. Student enrollment is counted if a student is registered for at least one course on the census snapshot data for each fall semester. Student enrollment includes degree-seeking and non-degree-seeking undergraduate and graduate students.
- b. The assessment of tuition and fee rates are based on where a student or student's family live. There are four broad residency categories: Resident (also called in-state), Non-resident (out-of-state), Tuition Reciprocity States, and International. Tuition Reciprocity programs include Midwest Student Exchange Cprogram, Ohio Reciprocity agreement counties, and residents in the four states contiguous to Indiana (Illinois, Michigan, Ohio, and Kentucky).
