Organized by the Office of Admissions, the “Herd Back to School: Summer Supply Drive” has a goal of filling 250 backpacks for those who can use some help with their supply list. Most-needed items are pencils, erasers, crayons, dry-erase markers, spiral and composition notebooks, plastic folders, pencil cases, and wired headphones. Additional supplies such as disinfectant wipes, tissues, hand sanitizer, washable markers, and glue sticks are also being accepted and will be available for students to choose from.

"She would gently hand them to me and then walk away," said Souleimane, a Purdue University Fort Wayne senior majoring in biology. "It was a small gesture, but it really stood out. It reminded me how even simple acts of kindness can make a lasting impression, and how meaningful these moments of connection can be."

Souleimane was among 11 students who recently traveled to Guatemala as members of PFW's **MEDLIFE** student organization to take part in a service project bringing medical care to remote

areas. Established in 2020 as part of a national organization, the chapter's purpose is to provide opportunities for pre-med and healthcare-interested students to learn more about the unmet needs in healthcare, while gaining hands-on experience. May's trip lasted a week.

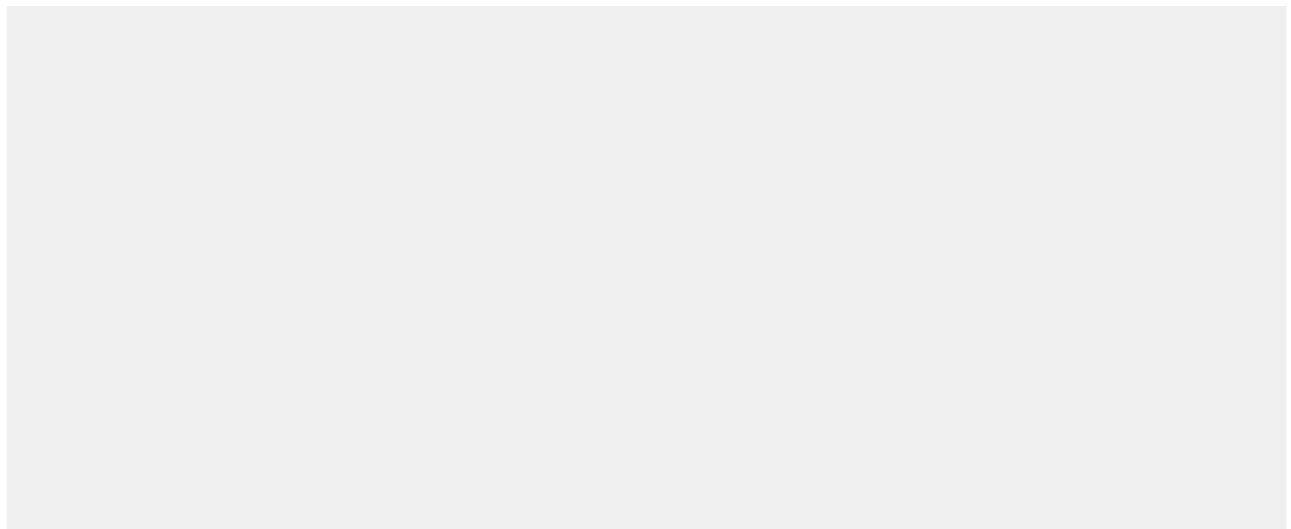
