Last year's gathering was held Feb. 24 inside Lutheran Health Fieldhouse, but the new date was chosen to offer more outside activities.

"This provides an opportunity and a space for all families to get back together, see where their students are, and check in on them," said Giang Petroviak, executive director of student success initiatives. "It's just about having that time for our students to see their parents and siblings again."

The festivities start at 9 a.m. with the **Campus United 5K** to benefit the FRIENDS of the University Pantry. That's followed by the Family <u>Day celebration</u> in the green space located east of

Helmke Library and north of parking garage P1. Highlights of the event will include food trucks, inflatable games, tie-dye shirts, and various vendors. The first 100 families to register will receive \$20 in food vouchers.
