The division is guided by the [U.S. Health Promoting Campuses Network](#) and the [Okanagan Charter](#).

Benefit Breakdown: Worker's Compensation

[Worker's Compensation](#) protects all university employees, including student employees, when they are injured or become ill due to a work-related injury, accident or illness. Worker's Compensation covers employees on university premises as well as travelling on university business.

If you are injured on the job, notify your supervisor right away, even if you do not require medical attention. If your injury is not life threatening, your supervisor will complete a "[First Report of Injury and Supervisor's Incident Investigation Form](#)" and contact Amy Jagger in Human Resources for authorization to send you to Parkview Occupational Health for medical treatment. HR will call ahead of your visit to assure Parkview is ready for your visit. If your situation is emergent or after hours, you can go to the emergency room immediately at Parkview Randalia or Parkview Regional Medical Center. If necessary, call 911 for immediate medical assistance.

Employees should not use their personal physician, campus clinic or athletic trainers for a work-related injury, only [authorized providers](#). Treatment through a provider not approved by JWF Specialty, Purdue's Worker's Comp insurance company, may not be covered and you would be responsible for any outstanding balances and bills.
