Resource Highlight: Native Trees of Indiana River Walk

The PFW campus is host to the Native Trees of Indiana River Walk! This walk is a 1.25-mile paved asphalt trail that takes you along the Saint Joseph River and features over 100 species of tree native to Indiana. Each tree is labeled with a plaque including the tree's name, a map of its native range, detailed photos of leaves, flowers, etc., and other facts about that species.

The trail starts at the end of Parking Lot 10 and ends near the Visual Arts building, with plenty of benches available along the route. You can learn more about the Native Trees of Indiana River Walk and get maps of the route and where each tree is located on the [trail's website](#).
