

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER A CARE REFERRAL IS SUBMITTED?



1. Referral Received

- A CARE member reviews the referral for concern, urgency, and safety and assesses risk. The information provided and the assessment help determine the next steps.

2. CARE Outreach

- The CARE member conducts multiple outreach efforts to the student to provide supportive, non-punitive assistance. Participation is encouraged but voluntary.

3. Possible Outcomes (CARE may take one or more of the following actions):

- The CARE team will reach out to the student, offer problem-solving support, and help them identify immediate next steps. The CARE team may refer the student to appropriate resources such as counseling, tutoring, disability access, financial aid, residential education, or other campus services. A referral may be closed when outreach has been completed, support has been offered, resources have been provided, and no further CARE follow-up is necessary at that time.

The CARE team aims to handle every situation with care. Student privacy, safety, and autonomy come first, and we work to ensure our support is balanced and student-centered.
