

Creating New GoReact Assignments in Brightspace

Overview

GoReact is a video-based assessment and feedback platform that allows instructors and students to record, upload, and review video performances while providing time-stamped feedback. It is commonly used in courses where students must demonstrate skills such as teaching, presentations, counseling techniques, clinical practice, or public speaking.

License: PFW has a campus-wide license for GoReact. All instructors and students can use GoReact through Brightspace integration at no cost.

Assignment Types:

- **Standard** GoReact assignments allow participants to record/upload a standalone video and submit it for feedback. Example use cases include presentations, classroom observations, and patient counseling.
- **Stimulus** assignments allow participants to record a video response to a video/PDF/image. The recorded response will be synchronized to the stimulus media. Example use cases include language practices and mock interviews.
- **Comment Only** assignments allow participants to evaluate a video without recording their own video response.

Peer Reviews: GoReact also supports peer review, where instructors can choose between open peer review (all students can view each other's feedback) or closed peer review (students only see feedback provided on their submissions).

Instructors can integrate GoReact with Brightspace so that assignments and grades connect directly to the course gradebook. When your course is integrated, both instructors and students must access GoReact through Brightspace. Do not create assignments or log in directly through goreact.com.

Important: Always access GoReact through Brightspace once integration is enabled.

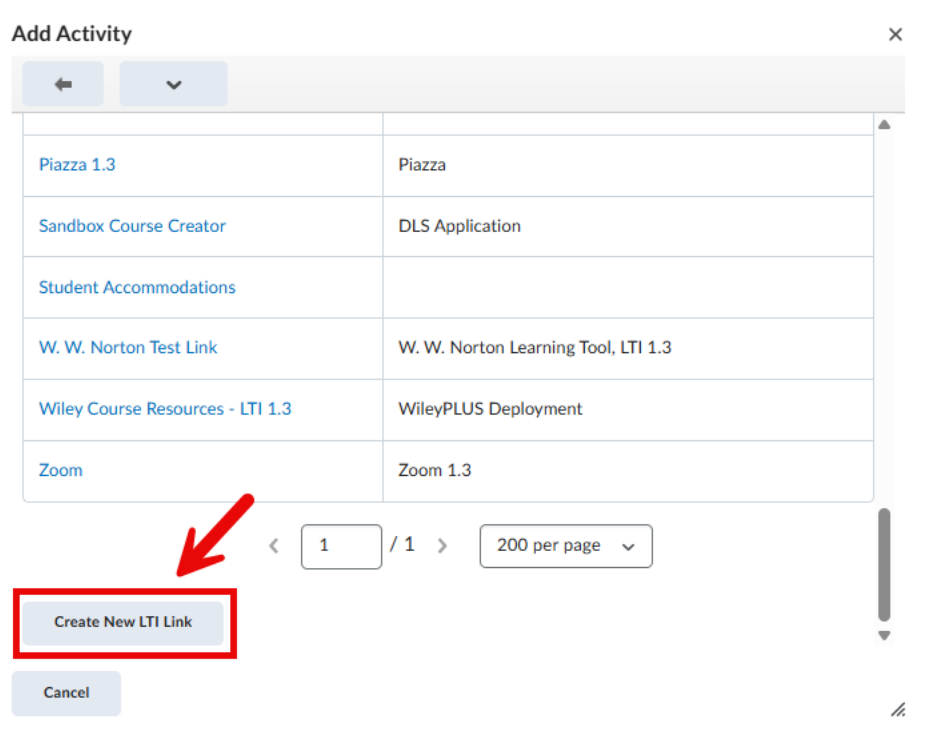

Part 1: Create a GoReact Assignment Link in Brightspace

1. Login to Brightspace.
2. Select the course.
3. Go to the **Module** where you want to add the GoReact assignment.
4. Select **Existing Activities > External Learning Tools**.
5. Scroll to the bottom of the pop-up window.
6. Click **Create New LTI Link** at the bottom.



7. Enter the following information in the pop-up window fields:
 - a. **Title:** add the unique assignment title
 - b. **LTI URL:** <https://lti.goreact.com/lti/v1>

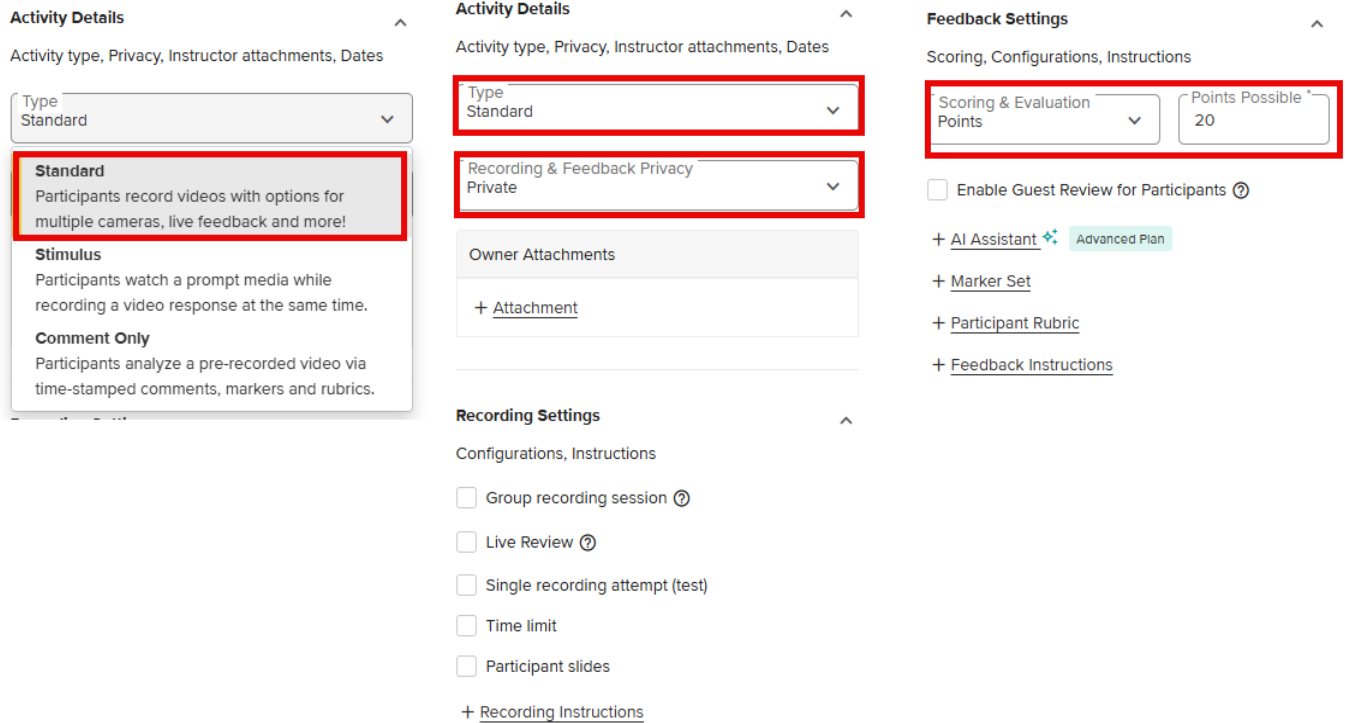
Note: Do not change the Tool option.

8. Select **Create and Insert**.

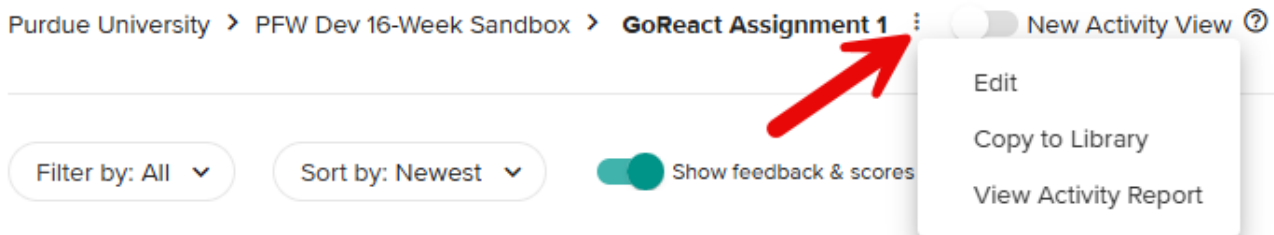
Part 2: Customize Settings for a New GoReact Assignment

This example demonstrates how to create a new standard private assignment worth 20 points.

1. Go to the **Module** with the GoReact assignment you want to customize.
2. Select the GoReact assignment title to open GoReact.
3. Select **Blank Activity** and choose the following options:
 - **Type:** Standard
 - **Recording & Feedback Privacy:** Private
 - **Scoring & Evaluation:** Points
 - **Points Possible:** 20
 - Leave all other settings as the default (unchecked)



4. Click **DONE** in the bottom right corner.
5. To edit settings after creating an assignment, click on the ellipsis next to the assignment name on the top of the screen. A panel will open on the right side of the screen with editing options. Note: The assignment name cannot be changed after it is created.

Part 3: Link a GoReact Assignment to a Grade Item

1. Select the GoReact assignment title to open GoReact.
2. Return to the Brightspace **Content** area where the assignment originated.
3. Select **Add a grade item** under **Assessment**.

4. Click the pull-down menu to link to an existing Grade Item or select **New Grade Item** to create a new one.
Note: Manually set the total points to match the point value for the assignment previously created in GoReact.
5. Select **Save**.
