



Get Started with YuJa Panorama in Brightspace

In case you missed the recent issue of *Purdue Today*, the Purdue system has selected YuJa Panorama as the supported digital accessibility remediation tool in preparation for compliance with the new digital accessibility standards issued by the Department of Justice under the Americans with Disabilities Act.

Panorama will be directly integrated into Brightspace to help instructors identify, assess, and address accessibility issues within courses and course content housed in Brightspace. Panorama will be made accessible to Brightspace instructors on May 26.

Several system-wide workshops will be offered during the last week of May to allow instructors to become acquainted with Panorama.
