From Orientation to Graduation: SSI Expands Student Support Across Campus

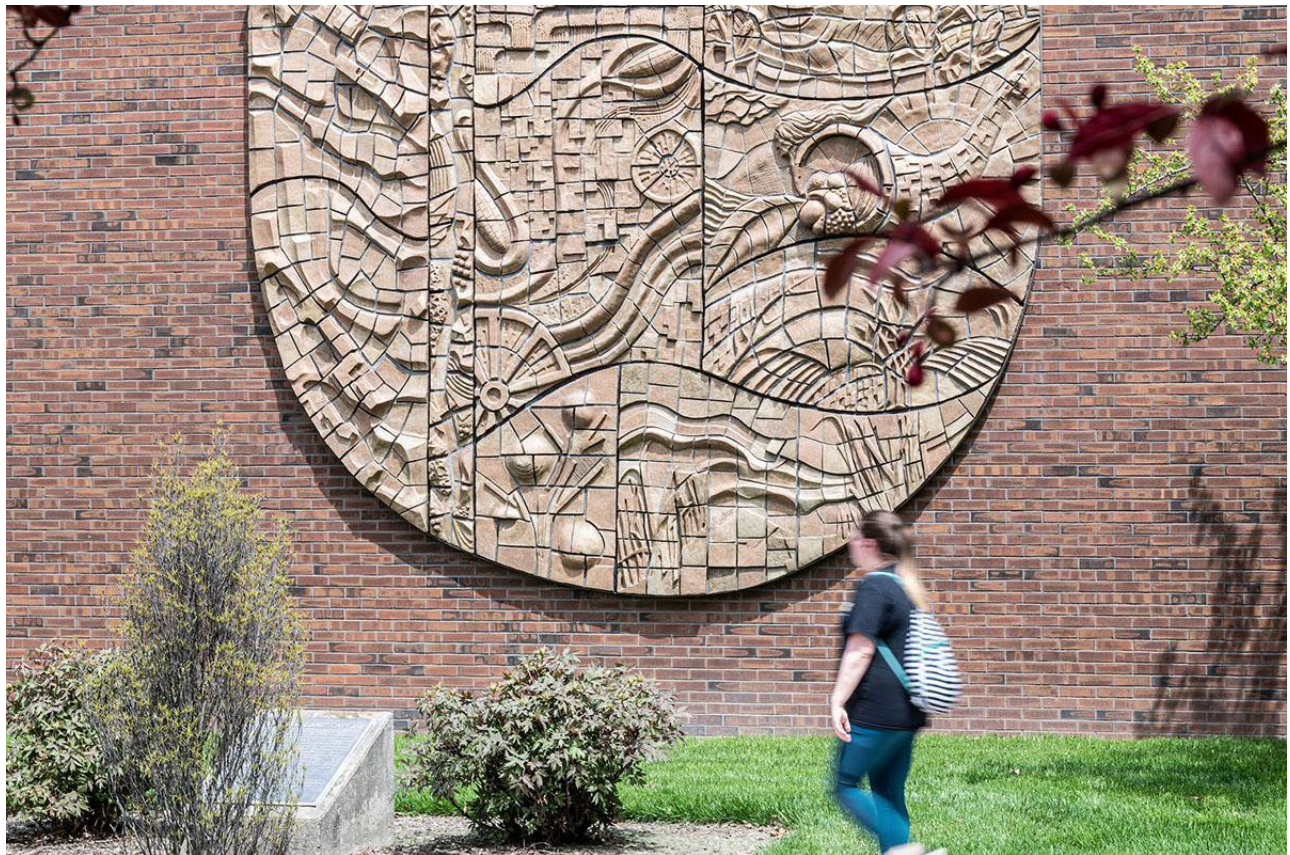

Departments interested in utilizing the newly available space are encouraged to complete the **Space Request and Assessment Form** by July 10.

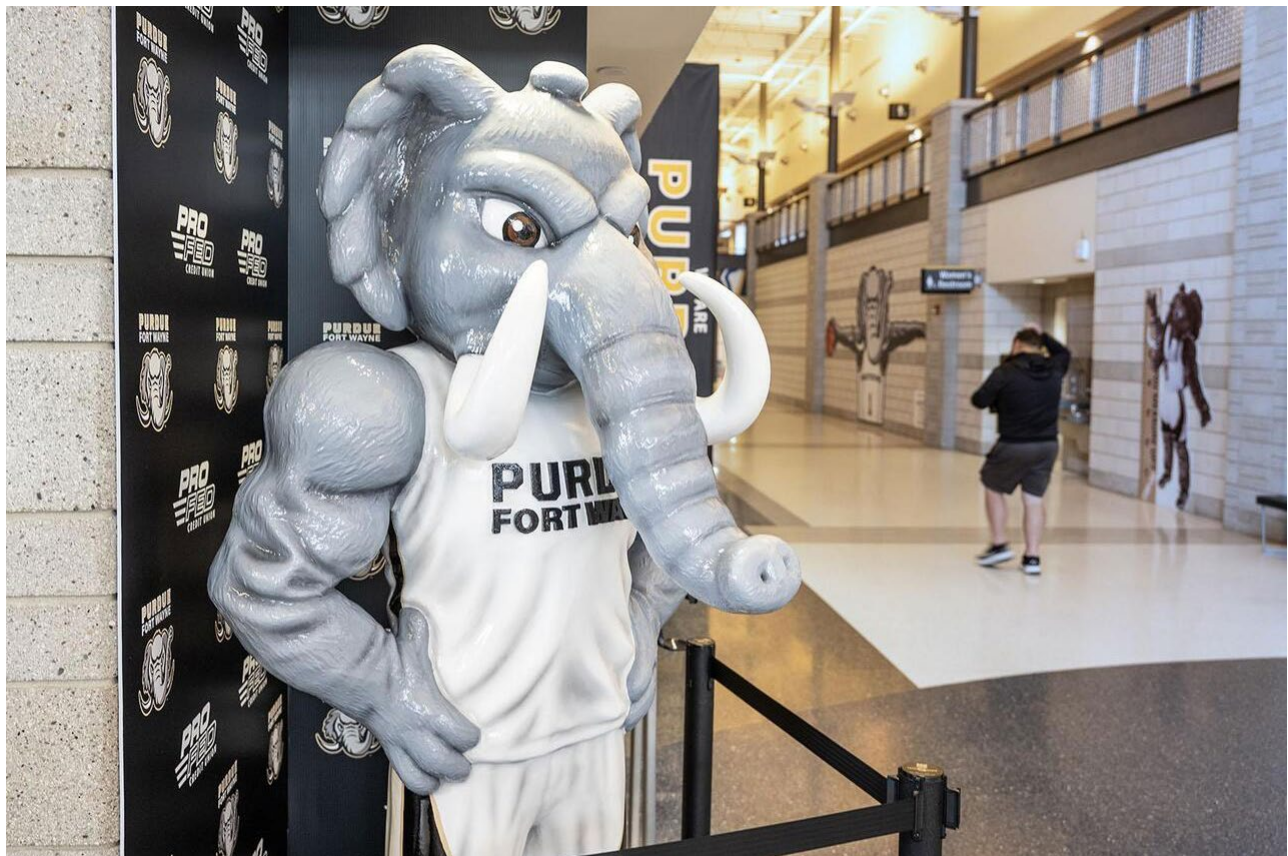
