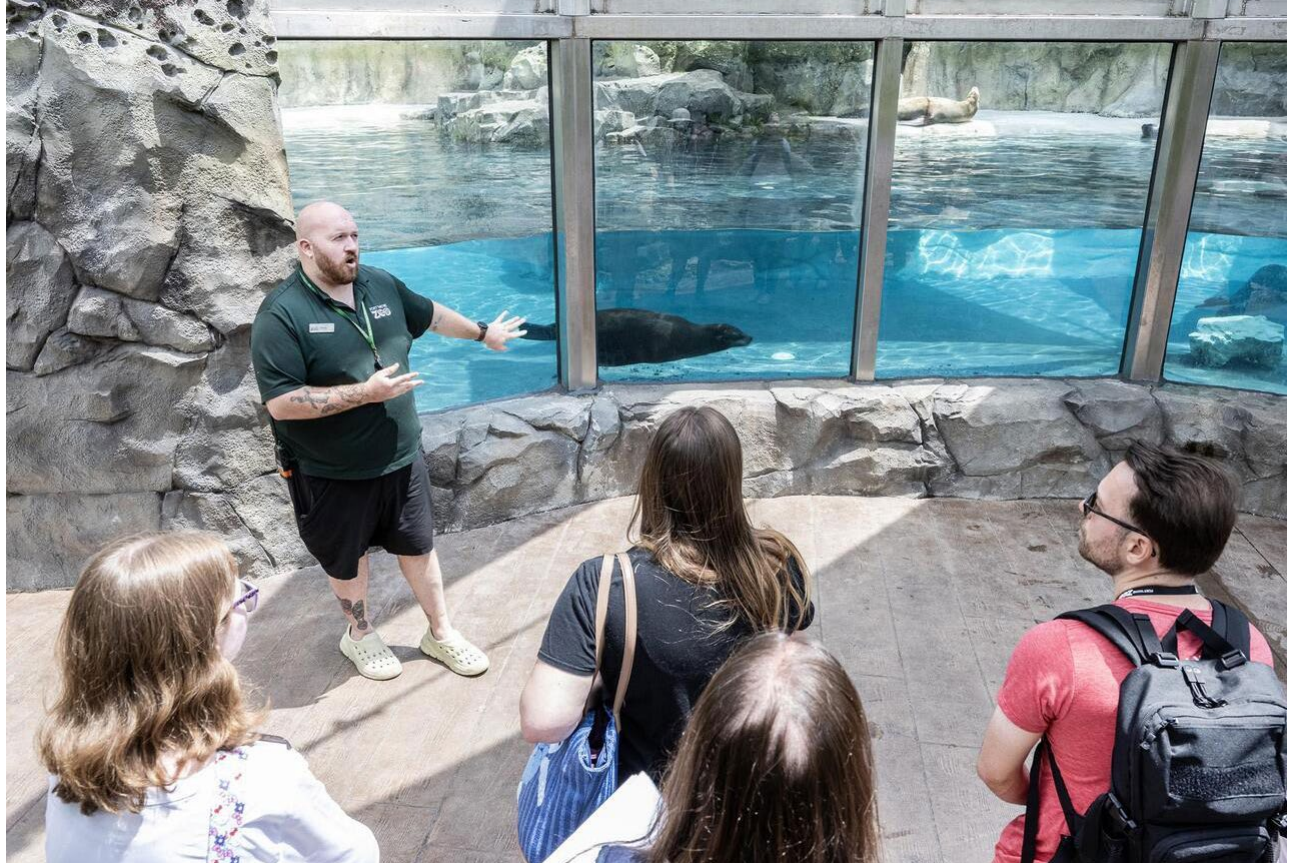




PFW Students Go Behind the Scenes at the Fort Wayne Zoo

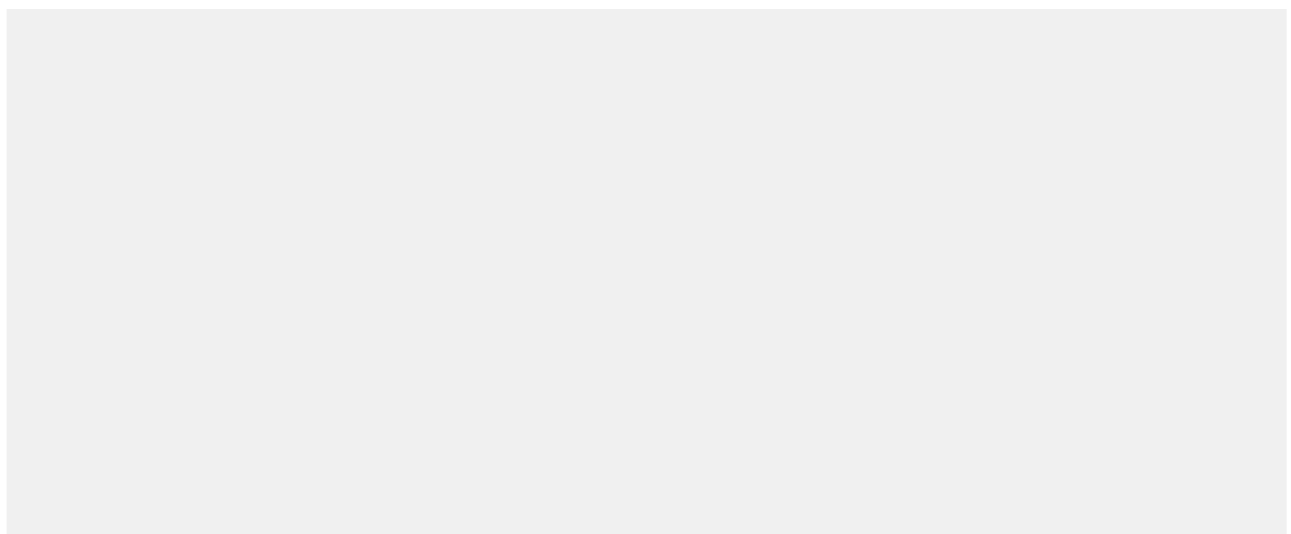
We wish everyone a safe and enjoyable holiday as we celebrate 250 years of America. Happy Independence Day!
