- ☐ Apply to Purdue Fort Wayne by **January 6, 2027**
- ☐ Current high school senior completing a Core 40 Diploma or other college-prep curriculum
- ☐ Meet one of the following:
 - 3.95 GPA + 90th percentile class rank
 - 1380 SAT or higher
 - 29 ACT or higher
- ☐ Eligible admitted students must complete the Summit Scholars application and essays by **January 15, 2027**.
